

All about Examinations

Academic year is divided into two semesters, the first from June/July to November/December and the Second from December/January to April/May. Each semester will have a minimum of 90 working days. Examinations will be conducted in papers of all semesters in Nov/Dec and April/May respectively for odd and even semesters every year for all UG and PG courses.

Attendance Requirement

- Students with 75% attendance are eligible to appear for the examinations.
- Student with 65 to 74% attendance are allowed to appear for examination on medical / sports Background.
- Students with less than 65% are eligible to write only arrear papers.
- Students Attendance percentage will be posted in Anna University web portal (<http://www.coe1.annauniv.edu>) every month as per the schedule given by the Anna University and students/parents could check their wards attendance particulars by logging in with students register number and data of birth.

Passing Requirements

To qualify for a pass, a student should secure minimum 50% marks in the examinations in case of UG and 50% marks in case of PG programmes.

- Four numbers of Internal Assessment Tests & one Model Test will be conducted during every semester.
- Internal Assessment Test marks will be posted in Anna University web portal (<http://www.coe1.annauniv.edu>) as per the schedule given by the Anna University and students / parents could check their wards performance by logging in with students register number and data of birth.
 - For Theory subjects - 4 Unit Tests & 1 Model Exam
 - For Practical Papers - 1 Model Practical Exam
